Need \$250 for security deposit. There will be one Biffy at the far end of the site. Jazood will e-mail and check in with the Champions.

**Ethnic Fest:** Next weekend! Begins on Saturday with Rapier on Saturday and Heavy Tournament on Sunday. Huge fighting demo. 2-3 different tourneys and some different things on Sunday.

**Autumn War:** Autumn War is coming along quite nicely! Here's what's new: The Autocrat is stressed beyond belief. The Dumpster, Biffies and Water are scheduled for delivery and pickup. The website is being updated frequently as new information comes in. Site map is being worked on. Schedule is being worked on. We have lots of Merchants (12 confirmed). We will be having lots of classes. Did I mention there might be some fighting, too? Will be working out the war points in the next week. Site copy will be completed about a week prior to the event. Remember that Pre-Reg ENDS on August 1st and you can only get a t-shirt if you pre reg and pre order!!! Site will be packed – camp close; don't spread out. We're getting requests for 1 large encampment per week. 939 site tokens in Baronial colors for the adults and 174 multicolored ones for the children are already complete. Warfield party planned for Saturday night. Barony of Wastekeep will be invading. As always, if you have any questions or concerns, don't hesitate to contact Lady Orabilia or me.

Several Knights and a Duke were among the contenders. Some BaO fighters in the Sunday tourney, who also did well. Youth Champion winner for her age group was Aubrey, Sabina's daughter; she won a leather pouch. We didn't keep a list at the Rapier tourney. We had only one fighter in and it was a fight 'till you drop competition. Thorbjorn represented us very well.

Glymm Mere would like for Her Excellency to run the Non-Crown lists at September Crown. Her Excellency mentioned that she will ask Vashti for help with the lists. Vashti is present and agrees to help, saying that Her Excellency should simply sign her up for whatever.

# Baronial Meeting Minutes: August 18, 2011

## Officer's Reports:

**Seneschal: Baron Yusuf** – Seneschal now has 2 deputies.

**Exchequer: Veronica Paone** – We've got money!

**Herald: Dafydd Caerfyrddin** – Many awards were given at Autumn War!! Thank you to Angharad for heralding Sunday Court for me, as I lost my voice doing speed court on Saturday. I will post a list of the awards, sometime in the near future, on the Baronial email list. I've been in Consultation with a few different members of the Barony on names and devices

**Arts & Sciences: Katheryn de Gonville** – The Siege Cooking class last month went well. No idea what the next class will be, but will post to the Gate when decided. Lots of good classes at Autumn War – we got good feedback.

**Marshal: Nels Ulfger I Jaren** – Autumn War is over. 1 injury not related to fighting – fell and landed on his shield and self-transported to medical professionals for a dislocated shoulder. Fight practice on Tuesday evenings. Crown is coming up!

**Rapier: Thorbjorn** – No injuries and no losses. We won all 4 war points. Nanny-nany-boo-boo! We even loaned the other side people to rebalance the number of fighters on each side (we took volunteers). We had between 14 & 17 Rapier on the war field towards the end. The fighting was super clean. Honor and chivalry prevailed. Fighters enjoyed the scenarios. Conditions were excellent.

**Archery: Leif Moonshadow** – Autumn War: Broke one brand new arrow first day it was used, but it'll be replaced. York Round was used by 4 people Friday night. Royal Rounds throughout. Split the war points. Most fun was playing darts with arrows. Thanks to all who helped. Warfield was crammed – Archery field was all BaO.

**Chronicler: Milisandia verch Watkyn** – Nothing to report.

**Chatelaine: Edith de Chelched** – Many requests for Gold Key at Autumn War. Next year there will be an information booth at Autumn War. We withdrew from Joint Base Lewis McChord demo. They told us we were not needed. They just wanted babysitters, essentially, and used people from outside the SCA for the demo.

**Chirurgian: Vashti** – Junkun was Autumn War CIC. 2 reportable injuries. One dislocated shoulder on the war field and one dislocated finger from setup. Both self-transported to medical professionals. No ambulances called.

## Events:

**Lord Defenders:** Paperwork turned in. Final check sent to Longbranch. E-mail went out with event info. Rapier Championship will be at the Lord Defender's Event.

Autumn War: This year's Autumn War was held at Nix Ranch in Chehalis, WA. The event ran from 8/11 to 8/15, 2011. Here are the attendee totals: Adults: 939, Youth: 112, Child: 124, Total Paid: 1051, Grand Total: 1175 This is an overall increase of 170 over last year. Total amount owed to the site owner is \$2102. We paid a \$1000 deposit, so we still owe the site owner \$1102. We seemed to have very few issues, this year. Here are the issues that were reported: 2 reportable Chirurgeon calls. One dislocated finger and one dislocated shoulder. 8 families were given warnings for not keeping their under 12 year old children within sight and sound of the responsible adult. We removed one family from site due to gross negligence, because the responsible adult left site while her 12 year old was wandering with his 9 year old cousin. The Autocrat team was in custody of these children for approximately 1 ½ hours before anyone came looking for them. I will be forwarding the name of the offender to the kingdom seneschal. 1 merchant was removed from site for use of illegal substances, which affected another attendee. We had numerous complaints about an aggressive dog, however that dog was always on lead and didn't harm anyone. 2 people went off the road at different times and broke off irrigation tops. The barony will be paying for the repairs. All in all, this was a very good event. There have been huge amounts of compliments to the Autocrat Team for the layout, the way things were run, etc. I am working on creating a post event survey to send out to the populace to find out what everyone thinks went well and what needs to be worked on.

**Harvest Fest:** Event bid by Edith on E-mail she sent in with report. Still at the same hall as in past years. Reserved for the 3<sup>rd</sup> weekend of November (19<sup>th</sup>).

## New Business:

There will be a work party at the Nix ranch on Saturday the 20TH at 9:00AM meeting at the ranch gate to fix the damage that occurred at the Autumn War event site, if you are able to attend please be on time so we can get all of us in at one time, many hands make light work. If you have a shovel or two to bring with you, it would help LOTS. Thorbjorn and Leiðólfur organizing.

New Kingdom law: 10% fee for any Barony holding an event on another Barony's lands. Keep in mind for next year's Autumn War, since it's in Fire Mountain Keep/Glymm Mere. Law is being reworked at a Kingdom level, but since Fire Mountain Keep worked very diligently it seems fair. Other potential sites suggested, but they don't work well with date/time.

Dafydd is working on writing up job descriptions for each position on the Autumn War Autocrat team for use next year. We will have each person sign a copy of their job description. This is similar to how the larger wars are run and will help to alleviate a couple of the miscommunications we had this year. Autumn War is tentatively scheduled for August 16-22<sup>nd</sup> in 2012.

His Excellency would like to thank the Autumn War team. He got many compliments. The only complaint was too many archers on the warfield. He would also like to thank the Baroness of Wastekeep and Tiernan and Miranda for attending despite the sad loss.

**Exchequer: Veronica Paone** – \$28,690 and change combined balances before today's deposit (Accepts money from Autumn War).

**Herald: Dafydd Caerfyrddin** – Nothing to report.

**Arts & Sciences: Kathryn de Gonneville** – Kathryn's final report; stepping down at Lord Defenders. Zoya will be taking over. Last month's A&S meeting went well. There was an Apron Dress/Sewing 101 class that was so well received that it will be repeated this month. Social at 6:30, class starts at 7. Class will be at Zoya's home. She will post the address to the Gate.

**Scribe: Annaka Poznanska** - We're down to the wire on the Lord Defender's Champions' new charters. They will be ready in time. The rest are coming along. Still need ideas for the Panther's Torch Design. Also, Annika needs the text that Baron Aleksii wrote resent to her. We're not painting any Kingdom charters for this reign, partly because of time restraints, but also because we haven't gotten any to be painted.

**Rapier: Thorbjorn** – Looking forward to Lord Defenders this weekend and I hope there are others there to fight for our Barony.

**Archery: Leif Moonshadow** – Practice is still Sundays at 1PM, at Skookum. We lent Glymm Mere our loaner gear for September Crown and it was not returned in the condition in which it was presented. No damage, but care was not taken.

**Chatelaine: Edith de Chelched** – A couple of new contacts – e-mails. One couple came to fighter practice/social and had a good time. The other couple is looking for a good opportunity to come to an event. Gold Key is well maintained and ready.

**Chirurgeon: Vashti** – Nothing to report.

**Chamberlain: Otto** – Trailer's ready to go.

**Chronicler: Milisandia verch Watkyn** – Summer 2011 Newsletter is complete, posted on the Website and printed (15 copies), which are up front with Their Excellencies. Fall 2011 Newsletter has been started.

## Old Business:

**Autumn War:** We made \$7,995.43 after all expenses – highest profit in 5 years. We will explore giving some to Fire Mtn. Keep as they have been so gracious and helpful. At Sept Crown, many of us received compliments about AW layout. Only 2 complaints total, both very personal to the individual with the complaint. Mr. Nix may open a 2nd road for us if we have AW there next year, one for entrance and one for exit.

**Repairs:** Repairs of the irrigation damaged at Nix Ranch during Autumn War went very fast and well. Deep Water Keep was indispensable. They brought tools, bodies, snacks and water, and worked very hard. Mr. Nix is very impressed and happy. Thanks to Thorbjorn for setting up the repairs and Baron Aleksii hopes to be able to thank Deep Water Keep personally, as well.

**Harvest Feast:** Sir Brand asked about checks from last year's dessert auction. They were given directly to the charity by the Barony, as required.

**Lord Defenders:** The Autocrat is currently packing but he would like to remind everyone to be there or be square. No rain is currently forecast. There will be a potluck. Zoya will send out the announcement and info on the Gate. People should bring items in containers that are disposable. Also, the Baron likes Mac-n-cheese, but it doesn't like him, so mac-n-cheese will make him sad and should not be provided in large quantities. Conversely, both he and his lovely Baroness like bacon-wrapped things, which, ideally, SHOULD be present in large quantities.

## New Business:

**Celtic Bardic:** Will be March 17<sup>th</sup> at Longbranch. One day, morning to night. The feast will be awesome! The Bardic activities will be awesome! Bring your bellies! Bring your fingers, voices, and other bardic accessories! Celtic Bardic will be more awesome than the most awesome awesomeness that ever occurred or ever will occur. Attend or you will miss out on the epic awesomeness!!!

**Lord Defenders:** Lord Defenders 2012 will be 9/21-23 and will be combined with Dragon's Lair's Last Chance at the Longbranch facility. This will be very cool! Each Barony will have their own champions tourneys, but there will also be a combined tourney.

**Autumn War:** Dafydd has submitted a bid for AW2012. Expenses will be less next year because of extra items that were purchased last year. Additionally, we'll be marking the irrigation better, saving us those repairs. Dafydd estimates approx. \$12K in profits in 2012 because of decreased expenses and increased attendance. The Warlord of the Summits has invited Blatha an Oir to come to their Eleventh Night celebration with a declaration of war, and if we do, the Summits would be delighted to be involved in 2012's war. Dafydd has volunteered to go providing he is provided with a scroll to read in Court, with a poetic declaration of War. He will consult with Aleksii.

**Sergeant Trials:** 10/1-2 At Skookum this year – venue change! Potluck dinner. We'll be trying to create a great hall out of Dragon's Wings. Still gathering lights and heaters.

**Harvest Feast:** Harvest Feast 2011 is about to open Pre-reg. Pyoter will handle that again this year. 11-19. Sir Brand will have a dessert auction again this year. We are not on the Kingdom Calendar for this year due to a conflict that Midhaven wouldn't allow. 2012 Harvest Feast will be the first Saturday in November and we're setting it up now to avoid the same problem next year.

**Honeywar:** 2012 will be "All About the Bacon" Sir Gernan has offered to make the bacon mead again, and Baron Aleksii will make bacon beer.

**Candlemas:** Baroness will be approaching Glymm Mere about possibly a combined Candlemass, since they're both smallish events. We're trying to put stuff on the Kingdom Calendar soon so as to avoid conflicts. We're going to need an Autocrat.
